Hatred for Trump & Biden Dualism Reveal State of U.S.

The unbridled hatred for Donald Trump, and the dualism (hypocrisy) of Joe Biden and Kamala Harris and many citizens, reveal the true state of at least half of the people of the United States. Through this short *GLC Series* email this week, I hope you will ponder these disturbing realities.

Beginning during the years I worked for a member of Congress, and then lived in the DC area for a total of 16 years, two vitally important lessons I learned were: (1) the importance of searching out the truth of matters by finding out the real facts, and not believing media headlines or opponent misrepresentations; and (2) that what a person actual does, or what they put their name to, or how they voted, or the friends they keep, reveal the truth of their beliefs and who they really are – not the sound bites, or what others said or accused, or their religious claims or practices.

Trump: Why do so many Americans hate Donald Trump? What did he actually do? I'll focus on one area, the sanctity of human life. From the first until his last week in office, President Donald Trump defended the sanctity of every human life from conception, appointed justices and judges who would do the same, and correspondingly opposed abortion, American taxpayer funds for abortions abroad, Planned Parenthood, and the selling of aborted baby body parts. On 18 January 2021, two days before he left office, he issued a Proclamation on National Sanctity of Human Life Day, 2021, beginning with this statement: "Every human life is a gift to the world. Whether born or unborn, young or old, healthy or sick, every person is made in the holy image of God." He and Vice President Mike Pence stood strongly for the protection of every baby in his mother's womb, and against the slaughter of the innocents. Hatred for Trump and all the good he did reveals hatred for the righteousness of God expressed through him.

Biden & Harris: On 20 January 2021, Joe Biden and his family went to church together. Then, with his hand on a huge family Bible, he was inaugurated as President of the United States. That evening at the White House Press Conference, when Press Secretary Jen Psaki was asked about President Biden's position on the Hyde Amendment (prohibits taxpayer funding of abortions in the USA), and the Mexico City Policy (prohibits USA funds for abortions in foreign nations), she replied: "I think we'll have more to say on the Mexico City Policy in the coming days. But I will just take the opportunity to remind all of you that he is a devout Catholic and somebody who attends church regularly. He started his day attending church with his family this morning." Then on 22 January 2021, the White House issued a Statement from President Biden and Vice President Harris on the 48th Anniversary of Roe v. Wade. They proclaimed: "The Biden-Harris Administration is committed to codifying and appointing judges that respect foundational precedents like Roe. . . . This commitment extends to our critical work on health outcomes around the world."

Full of hypocrisy, Biden and Harris go to church, and then use the power entrusted to them to create policies, appoint judges, and authorize American taxpayer dollars for abortion, both in the U.S. and anywhere in the world. In fact, as soon as they have their ambassadors and diplomats in place, the pro-abortion policies of the Biden-Harris administration will be advocated, likely with coercive tactics, through their embassies and consulates in every nation, and through international and United Nations meetings and agencies.

Abortion, the Bible and Christian Faith: Is promoting abortion – intentional murder of unborn children – acceptable to God and consistent with the Bible and Judeo-Christian faith? Absolutely not! First, the Bible and nature reveal that God creates every child in His image, in his mother’s womb (Genesis 1:26-27; Ecclesiastes 11:5; Psalm 139:13-16). Second, God commanded us, “thou shalt not murder” (Exodus 20:13). Third, when God’s own people were sacrificing their children to idols – to demons – following the practice of the heathen nations, God Himself said, never “had it entered My mind that they should do this abomination, to cause Judah to sin” (Jeremiah 32:35; 7:31; 19:5; 1 Corinthians 10:20) – or that U.S. leaders would “cause (Americans) “to sin.”

God’s Assessment: What was God’s assessment and final judgment of leaders who sacrificed their own children, or authorized and enabled others to do so? He said they “did evil.” For example, “Manasseh . . . did evil in the sight of the LORD, according to the abominations of the nations whom the LORD dispossessed . . . For he rebuilt the high places . . . and erected altars . . . made his son pass through the fire [child sacrifice] . . . shed very much innocent blood until he had filled Jerusalem from one end to another . . . and the LORD would not forgive” (2 Kings 21:1-6, 16; 24:4). What former President Donald Trump and Vice President Mike Pence did in protecting human life from conception was according to the good, righteous, and just will of God. But what President Joe Biden and Vice President Kamala Harris are commencing to do is the same as King Manasseh did, and is directly contradictory to the Bible and Christian faith, and is evil.

U.S. Citizens: What does all this reveal about citizens of the United States? The choice of Biden and Harris over Trump and Pence, including by clergy, churchgoers, and self-identified “Christians,” reveals that Americans are more deeply affected by the perceptions presented to them by media, than the facts of who a person truly is or what they stand for or actually did. That choice also reveals that a majority of Americans think they can go to church, murder their babies or support abortion, and somehow that is okay with God. Those present realities reveal a deep crisis of character in the American people and our leaders. It’s time we took an honest look at ourselves and who we have become.
