the 100th Anniversary of the First Nation Authorizing Abortion

Background and results: On 18 November 1920, the former Russian Soviet Federated Socialist Republic – which later expanded to the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (U.S.S.R.) – became the **first government in history to authorize elective abortion**. This year, 18 November 2020 marks the 100th year anniversary of that abortion decree that started a global movement among nations resulting in the Greatest Genocide in history. As a result, **1.1 Billion Babies** have been murdered by abortion in **1 century** within **137 nations** who authorized abortion, including 62 million in the United States. Worldwide, 40,000 unborn babies are murdered every day.

Spiritual reality: By the design of the Creator, when innocent blood is shed it cries out to God continually for justice and atonement [1]. The sacrifice of preborn or newly born children is innocent bloodshed that brings the inevitable and irreversible judgment of God upon nations. By command of Pharaoh, ancient Egyptians murdered newborn sons of the Israelites [2]. When God judged them, He brought 10 plagues upon Egypt. In the final plague, the angel of death took the lives of the firstborn in every household [3]. The lands that God gave to Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and Israel were at that time the world capital of child sacrifice [4]. When God brought Israel out of Egypt, He used them to wipe out those particular nations. Yet centuries later, when Israel and Judah were committing the same sins of immorality, idolatry and child sacrifice, God brought judgment upon them [5]. We would be wise to assume that present plagues, disasters, political divisions, etc., are evidence that God has withdrawn His favor and protection from our nations, and unleashed judgments upon us until we humble ourselves and repent of our sins.
