Biden Revokes Pro-Life Mexico City Policy

GLC Strategic & GLC Series Changes. It's Time to Rebuild

On 28 January 2021, President Joseph R. Biden, Jr., issued an Executive Order to revoke The Mexico City Policy (that had prohibited U.S. taxpayer dollars from funding any organization that performed or promoted abortion in other nations). President Ronald Reagan created the Mexico City Policy in 1984; but President Bill Clinton rescinded it in 1993; then President George W. Bush reinstated it in 2001; then President Barack Obama rescinded it in 2009; and then President Donald J. Trump reinstated and “substantially expanded these restrictions” prohibiting abortion in his first week in office, in 2017. Under the Biden-Harris Administration, the U.S. Government will likely again become the biggest funder of abortion and abortion-promoting services and advocacy worldwide, meaning American tax dollars will be used again to kill countless babies. Removal of the Mexico City Policy and other abortion restrictions means that governments and nations worldwide who protect pregnant women and preborn babies will be targeted by the Biden-Harris Administration, and continually pressured or coerced to change their policies to authorize abortion on demand. Through every U.S. embassy and consulate, through USAID country programs, through foreign aid programs, through the United Nations and its agencies and programs, including UNFPA, officials and representatives of the U.S. Government will pressure nations to remove restrictions to abortion.

GLC Strategic & GLC Series changes: The Global Life Campaign was formed in part to help pro-life countries preserve their righteous and just policies protecting pregnant women and preborn babies, including by equipping them to resist coercive pressure from pro-death governments and organizations. The GLC is an advocate for the preborn by going to nations and their leaders, recommending policies and practices that protect the sanctity of all human life, from conception to natural death. Therefore, the GLC is in the process of considering relocation to another country in a region that will be heavily targeted by the Biden-Harris Administration. The GLC Board of Governors has begun the process of exploring moving the headquarters to Latin America. In addition, the GLC is directing substantial focus for the next few months to become digital, mobile, and operational anywhere in the world. Please pray for us to have the wisdom and resources to accomplish this goal and know the direction we are to take.

Time to REBUILD: What we are facing has occurred on our watch. The Church universal is culpable because we withdrew from being salt and light and being “the pillar and the support of the Truth” (1 Timothy 3:15) in every sector of society. Light comes from light and overcomes the darkness. But darkness does not come from light, and there is no light if those in whom the light exists cover up their light. We abandoned leadership and responsibility in

the Church, education, media, medicine, government, etc. The evil has been able to penetrate and overcome in our absence or silence. Both the shepherds (clergy) and the sheep (believers in Christ) are at fault. But we need the shepherds to shepherd the sheep – to make us true disciples of Jesus Christ who know and walk in the truth.

It is time to rebuild the spiritual, moral and truth foundations of our nation. That rebuilding begins by remembering the God of our fathers, recovering and remembering the Truth God has given us in the Bible for every area of life, remembering the true history of our nation, and remembering the great influence of Christian leaders and the Judeo-Christian faith. That rebuilding must be done through the Church, especially through the clergy, who must once again take up their mantels of leadership.
