Total abortions, 1926-2019: **61,178,000**

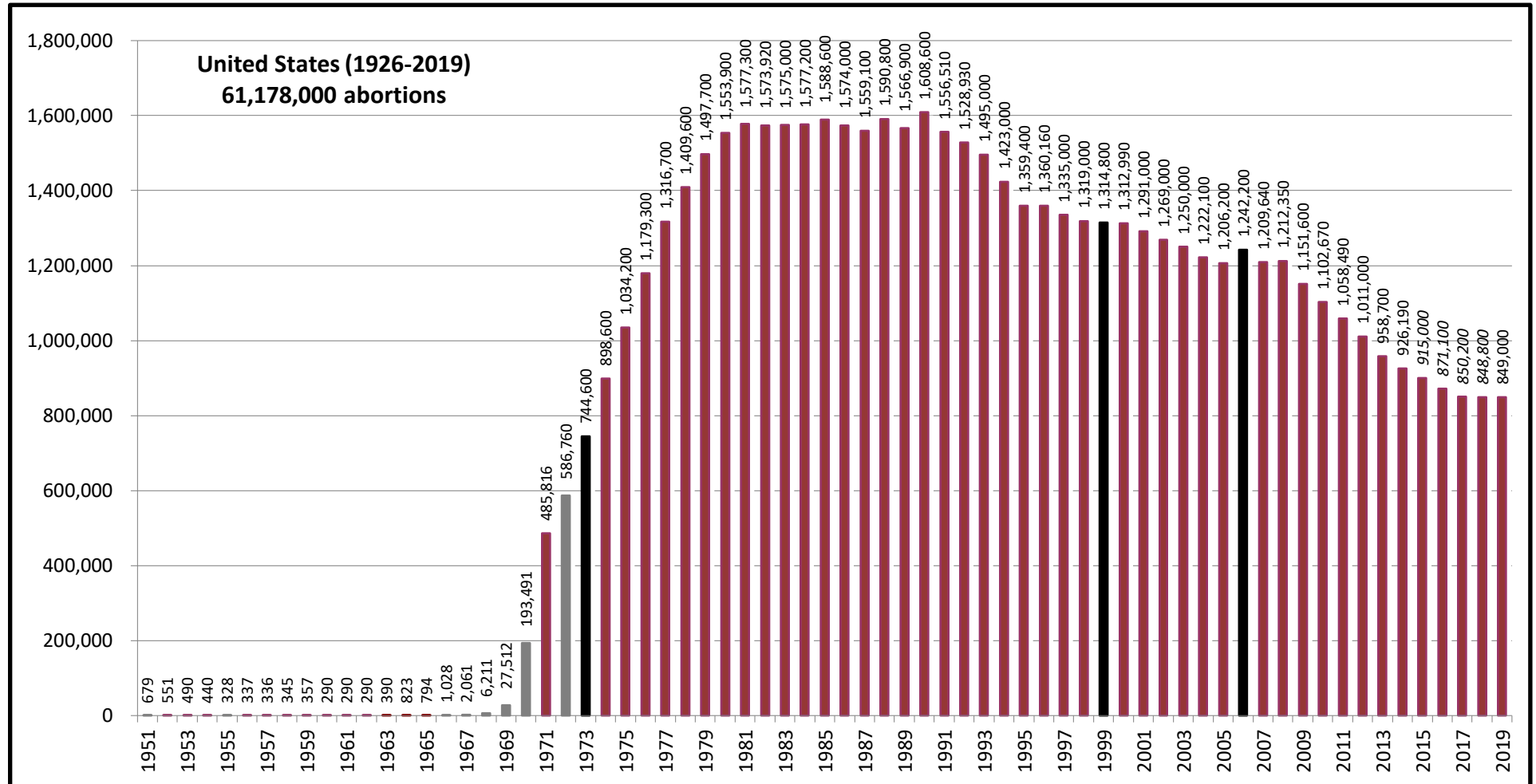
Abortion illegal: 1800s – 1950s-70s, regulated by states

(current 2,330 abortions every day ≈ 9/11 tragedy for unborn babies)

Abortion authorized partly or fully: 1951–1972 in 21 states; ^1973 on demand national

(total abortions = 18.4% of current population, or 26 of 50 States + DC)

1951: AL. **1955:** NH. **1966:** MS. **1967:** CO, CA, NC, OR. **1968:** GA, MD. **1969:** AR, DE, KS, NM. **1970:** AK, HI, MA, NY, SC, VA, WA. **1972:** FL. **1973:** *Roe v. Wade*



Grey: year abortion was authorized by some states, all restricted except for Hawaii, Massachusetts and New York in 1970.

Black: year abortion was authorized on demand (1973) nationwide, or for abortifacients (1999, 2006); (^ = increased access)

Crimson red: Innocent bloodshed and the number of reported abortions that year.

Italicized number: estimated number based on research of data, and actual reported number(s) from prior year(s), which may include partial reporting.
