Report on Day of Repentance for Abortion

The first National and Global Day of Repentance for Abortion was held last week, on 18 November 2020, the 100th anniversary of the first national abortion decree authorizing abortion, followed by 137 nations and 1.1 billion lost babies. Those of us who gathered from 5 continents for the online solemn event hosted by the Global Life Campaign sensed the Presence and guidance of the Spirit of the Lord in our midst. Quickly after I started the prayer meeting, and we got on our knees and humbled ourselves before the Lord, it was evident that the Holy Spirit was in charge and had prepared each one who was asked to read Scripture or pray for their nation or region. This was a holy time before the Lord and Ruler of the nations, confessing the sins of our nations, especially abortion, and remembering before Him the total number of babies lost in our nation, region, and worldwide, that they shall never be forgotten.

Now may we see God move among the nations in and through His people to end abortion in every nation, and restore us to cultures who love God and cherish every human life.

Afterwards, participants indicated they want this to be an annual event, and one pro-life leader has already requested that we assist her in organizing a similar event for her nation on the anniversary of the day that restrictions on abortion were removed.
